The selected 4-H showmanship winner for Goat, Dairy, Horse, Beef, Lamb, Dairy Feeder Calf, And Swine 4-H Clubs will compete for a Round Robin Showmanship Award.

Date: Thursday, July 24

Beef/Dairy Arena – 8:00 p.m.

Judges: A judge residing outside of Elkhart County will select the winners of the large animal competition.
Awards: Traveling Trophy presented by Mr. Don Thomas.
 Banners and Rosettes presented by Mr. Harold Campbell, Campbell Auction Service.

Rules for “4-H Round Robin Showmanship Contests”

2008

1. Once you have won the round robin contest you become ineligible for future round robin competition.
2. If a 4-H member wins showmanship honors in more than one specie they may select the specie they may select the specie they wish to represent and the reserve winner in the other specie will represent that specie in the round robin contest.
3. Testing procedures are in place for all contestants to be used as a tie breaker if needed.

GENERAL LIVESTOCK RULES

1. The superintendent in each department has the right to tell each exhibitor where to tie his animal or in what pen it should be placed.
2. No straw will be furnished by the Fair.
3. Judging will follow the outline given under each project. It is up to each club member to get his animal in the ring when the classes are called - leaders and others are not responsible for seeing that the animal is shown.
4. No 4-H'er will be allowed to stay overnight on the Fairgrounds. The only exception to this will be for 4-H'ers who will be staying at the campgrounds with their parents/guardians.

STATE FAIR ENTRY

All 4-H Livestock Members wishing to make State Fair entries must obtain the appropriate copies of their livestock enrollment form from the Extension office. This must be done by Friday, May 16.
