To accommodate the large crowd that is expected to attend the Lady Antebellum performance on July 26, 2010 and for the convenience and safety of guests, the Fair has approved the following:

All gates at CR 34 will be closed from midnight Sunday through 5:00 a.m. Monday with the exception of Gate 2, which will be handled by a security guard, in the event emergency vehicles might need to enter or exit the fairgrounds. Gate 5 and Gate 1 will open at 5:00 a.m. so exhibitors may enter to care for their livestock and those persons with campsites may leave if necessary. Parking will open to the general public at 7:00 a.m. The fair will open at 8:30 a.m. as normal. Seating in the grandstands will begin at 9:00 a.m. until filled. Everyone must be present to obtain a wristband to enter the grandstands. Wristbands will be limited to the number of seats available.
