1. Entry may be made up until time of weigh-in on Thursday, July 17th. Weigh-in time will be 6:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. Winner will be determined at that time. All other entries are released at this time. Entry fee will be \$10.00.
2. Winner must stay on exhibit until Thursday, July 24th at 4:00 p.m. At this time the winner will be dismissed to make room for auction on Friday.
3. Boars may be of any age or breed, but must meet all health requirements the same as other swine showing at the Elkhart County 4-H Fair.
4. Entries must be reasonably sound (able to walk, etc.)
5. Prizes will be as follows:

6. Entries must come from Elkhart or adjoining counties.
