Market Barrow Show following Gilt Classes

Elkhart County Swine club members pay only \$1.00 for each project animal if the animals are signed up and money paid by Sunday July 25th. \$3.00 per head for Elk. Co. 4-Her's after Sunday. All others are \$5.00 per pig.

2. ENTRIES ARE LIMITED TO RESIDENTS OF ELKHART AND ADJOINING COUNTIES ONLY. (Counties include St. Joseph, Noble, LaGrange, Kosciusko, Marshall, Indiana and St. Joseph, Cass County, Michigan)
3. Entry blank can be found in the Elkhart County 4-H fair book or online at <http://www.4hfair.org/4-H.htm> and are to be turned in to the Superintendent, NOT LATER THAN NOON SATURDAY, JULY 4. NOTICE: If entry is received on or before the deadline date, admission ticket for exhibitor will be mailed.
4. All animals must be the property of the exhibitor at the time of making entries.
5. Exhibitors may enter two (2) animals in a given class as he or she chooses.
6. Classes will be divided by the discretion of the superintendent.
7. All purebred animals must meet breed standards according to the National Swine Registry.
8. All crossbred gilts will show by weight.
