2017 General Tractor Rules

- No alcoholic beverages will be allowed.
- Contest will take place **Thursday, July 27** at 8:00 A.M. Sharp!
- Recommended for 10 & 12,000 & 15,000 classes - dead man throttle - air shut off - wheelie bars - roll bar
- 3,000 RPM limit on all Farm Stock, 6 mph and Too Hot for Farm classes.
- Single turbo
- 30 or more hooks, then only one hook per tractor
- Judges' decisions are final. Judges have the right to stop and/or disqualify any contestant if tractors are being operated in an unsafe manner, or if cheating is suspected.
- All minors must have written consent of parent or guardian, and must be at least 17 years of age to pull in tractor or truck classes.
- All entries must be made and fees paid at judges stand for pulling classes at least one-half (1/2) hour before class is scheduled to pull.
- **All tractors with turbos and no mufflers must have 2 cross bolts with straight pipes.**
- Only two (2) drivers allowed per tractor (must be different drivers), and driver must remain seated while pulling and retain one (1) hand on steering wheel at all times.
- Only one pull allowed unless tie is declared. Pull is ended when forward motion stops. No jerking or hole digging is allowed.
- Floating finish, no pulloff.
- Pull will begin with tight chain.
- Stationary drawbar is to be 20" or less.
- Clevis on tractor must have large opening (about 3 3/4 inches).
- If any weights are hung on three point hitch, hitch must stay in up position and not interfere with hook and unhook.
- The first driver in each class has the option to drop to the third position.
- At the conclusion of each individual's pull, they shall cross the scales for an official weight.
- All tractors must be in neutral or park while being hooked to, or unhooked from, the sled.
- Any part of the tractor that comes off and falls to the ground while hooked to the sled, will be an automatic disqualification.
- #2 fuel only. No ice boxes. No fuel additives. No propane. No nitrous oxide.
- Pulling positions will be determined by draw before each class starts.
- In case of rain, pull will be cancelled and entry fee refunded if class has not started or pulled.
- **SAFETY IS VERY IMPORTANT!**
- **JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL AND WILL BE PRESENT!!**

Additional Class Rules

Too Hot to Farm

- 3,000 RPM limit, must have ISSPro #R8906 single magnetic pickup attached to front of engine to measure RPMs. Wire from the pickup to back of tractor must be 14-16 gauge continuous wire attached to the 2 main spades of a female electrical outlet.
- May have top cut tires, no V-cuts allowed.
- Must maintain stock appearance. Must have OEM frame rails and front end or aftermarket equivalent.
- Cannot pull in Farm Stock or 6 mph class.

Farm Stock

- 3,000 RPM limit.
- No speed limit.
- Single or dual wheels allowed. No cut or shaved tires.
- Cannot pull in Speed Limit or Too Hot to Farm class.

6 MPH Farm / Field Stock

- 3,000 RPM limit.
- 6 mph speed limit.
- Single or dual wheels allowed. No cut or shaved tires.
- Cannot pull in Farm Stock or Too Hot to Farm class.
- Must be field worthy.
